Promoting the further education of our youth in Mississippi and Louisiana

In 2018, Southern AgCredit will award up to 20 scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each to graduating high school seniors who plan to attend an institution of higher education within the next year.

Scholarship winners will be selected based on school and community involvement, scholastic performance, educational goals and financial needs. Winners will be announced in May 2018.

To be eligible to apply, you must be a child, grandchild or spouse of a current Southern AgCredit borrower or be a borrower yourself. *Children or grandchildren of the Southern AgCredit Board of Directors or employees are not eligible to apply.*

Selection Criteria

- **Scholarship:** measured by grades and transcripts (5 points)
- **Leadership:** measured by positions held in student government, civic and church groups (10 points)
- **Extracurricular activities:** measured by participation in sports, school and community organizations, as well as work experience (10 points)
- **Essay:** measured by content and message (25 points)
